## Biography

She has been involved in the study of ruminant fermentation since 1989. She deals with influencing of fermentation processes and lipid metabolism in the gastro-intestinal tract (GIT) of ruminants and development and improvement of methodologies for measuring of the GIT gas production of ruminants. She contributed significantly to practical use of in vitro GIT simulation methods in the laboratory. She is author of 60 scientific papers published in international refereed journals. She has been investigator of international European projects within the 5th Framework Programme (ERCULE and CIMES) and an international project COST Action FA1302 and as well as of several national projects. She actively participated in many national and international conferences. She supervised 5 PhD students of the University of Veterinary Medicine and Pharmacy Kosice in subject area of Veterinary Morphology and Physiology.
